She graduated from Shimer College., IL with a Bachelor of Arts degree and attained Riji, the highest teaching rank of the Sogetsu School in 1977. Major positions she had held include President of Ikebana International New York Chapter for 2 terms and Founder /Director of Sogetsu New York Branch 1970-1991. Her arrangements have been exhibited in various venues such as the Metropolitan Museum of Art, Museum of Natural History, Nippon Club, Bronx Botanical Garden, New York Botanical Garden, Bergdorf Goodman, Bloomingdale's Department Store and Whitney Museum. She also shared her passion and knowledge of ikebana in her book "Flowers are...East and West", published in 1993.
